BOWL OF BROOKLANDS

11.45 a.m. The Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh arrive at the Bowl of Brooklands.

(The general lay-out is on the attached plan)

The New Zealand Ensign shall be flown from the centre flagpole. As the Queen arrives the Royal standard shall be "broken" on the front flagpole.

Met By:-

The Mayor of New Plymouth and Chairman of the Bowl of Brooklands Trust, Mr D.V. Sutherland, and Mrs Sutherland. The Town Clerk, Mr W.J. Connor.

The Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh, escorted by Mr and Mrs Sutherland, proceed on a walk through the rows of spectators to their seats (see route plan on attachment).

The Town Clerk will, meantime escort the Royal Household and New Zealand Party to their places.

His Worship the Mayor presents the Deputy Chairman of the Taranaki County Council, Mr R.L. Osborne, and Mrs Osborne.

When the Royal Party is seated the Variety Performance commences.

Note: For a plan of the procession and the seating see attached (All seats must be carded).

At the conclusion of the Variety Performance, The Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh, accompanied by Mr and Mrs Sutherland, walk across a small bridge to the stage where the principal artist(s) will be presented.

The Queen and the Duke of Edinburgh are then escorted to their car by Mr and Mrs Sutherland who take their leave.
